Information for parents on our homework policy



Homework is daily reading, and weekly spellings, number bonds —

children are tested weekly for spellings and number bonds.



Each child receives homework books—they are to be completed when the learning has been carried out in school—it is a practice tool.



Home learning project: half termly—this is compulsory, high quality expectations with a deadline for handing it in. All home learning projects are available on our website:

YEAR 1

- Home learning projects are given out each half term.
- Spelling—in the Autumn term, we send out a general list for the half term with exception words for the Y1 curriculum which children must learn to spell. From Spring onwards, we send home weekly spellings linked to phonics and the exception words. They are kept in the white reading log and homework book.
- Children are expected to read 10-15 minutes each night. Reading books are changed as often as children read them. Please remember to write in the home reader book which pages have been read and make any comments about their children's reading preferences, fluency or things they found tricky.
- Homework books: From Spring term, we send home a weekly sticker in the reading record book to tell parents which pages to do. This reinforces what we have taught already in class.
- Each child also has a Mathletics and Oxford Owl login, written in the reading record book, so that they can develop their skills further as directed by you.
